PRIVACY POLICY

– given in compliance with Article 13
of the EU Regulation 2016/679 relating
to personal data (“privacy regulation”)

This Privacy Policy is given in compliance with Article 13 of the EU Privacy Regulation, by the Cultural Association “FLAT”, acting as the controller, only relating to the FLAT’s Internet web site with domain name www.flatartbookfair.com and not for other Internet web sites, which the user can surf through a link on www.flatartbookfair.com.

CONTROLLER OF THE DATA PROCESSING

The controller is FLAT, Cultural Association, Fiscal Code 97805090012, VAT Number 11768180017, with registered office in Turin, via Giovanni Giolitti no. 55, in person of its legal representative, Ms. Caroppo Chiara.

MODALITIES AND PURPOSES OF THE PROCESSING

The personal data given to FLAT will be mainly processed with computer instruments, for the limited purposes hereinafter indicated and for the time strictly necessary in order to accomplish the purposes for which they have been collected.

Appropriate security measures are set up in order to prevent accidental loss, unlawful or unfair uses, unauthorised access to the personal data.

The personal data furnished by the users through the filing of the format present on the Internet web site shall be used for the following purposes:

- a) examining the candidature of the users in order to participate to the event “Turin Art Book Fair” organized by FLAT, allowing the subsequent enrolment and the creation of a list of the expositors, who will participate at the above-mentioned event, which will be published on the Internet web site www.flatartbookfair.com. Each expositor will be indicated with the domain name of its web site (if communicated). Such provision of personal data is a requirement necessary to enter into the contract, an eventual refusal entails the impossibility to enter into such contract;
- b) in case of admission to the event, create and sending via e-mail the invoice for the participation fee to be paid to FLAT. Such provision of personal data is a requirement necessary to enter into the contract, an eventual refusal entails the impossibility to accomplish the contract;
- c) sending via e-mail communications relating to the FLAT event “Turin Art Book Fair”, according to the executed contract; an eventual refusal entails the impossibility to accomplish the contract;
- d) sending via e-mail communications relating to future similar events organized or promoted by the Cultural Association FLAT. The communication of personal data is optional; an eventual refusal entails the impossibility to obtain service of up-date about such future events;
- e) sending newsletter via e-mail. The communication of personal data is optional; an eventual refusal entails the impossibility to obtain the newsletter’s service.

The data subject has the right to withdraw the consent at any time, without affecting the lawfulness of processing based on consent before its withdrawal.

The personal data furnished could be processed by the controller and also by the employees and collaborators of the controller specifically appointed by the controller, to whom the controller has given specific operative instructions, with particular reference to the minimum level of security measures required by the Privacy Regulation, which will be adopted in order to guarantee the privacy and security of personal data.

Personal data collected will be saved and stored for not more than the time strictly necessary in order to accomplish the purposes for which they have been collected and/or used, according to what the applicable law and the Privacy Authority establish, and also for the periods which correspond to the prescription period of the legal action that the parties could start.

RIGHTS OF THE DATA SUBJECTS

The data subjects have the right, in every moment, to obtain the confirmation of the existence of personal data processing, and in such case to know the purposes of the processing, the categories of personal data concerned, the envisaged period for which the personal data will be stored, the recipients to whom the personal data could be disclosed. Data subjects have, also, the right to ask the rectification or erasure of personal data or restriction of processing of personal data concerning the data subject or to object to such processing. The Privacy Regulation recognizes also the right to data portability and the right to lodge a complaint with a supervisory authority (article no. 15).

This right will be exercised, free and in every moment, filing specific written request to: Cultural Association FLAT, with registered mail addressed to its registered office in Turin, Via Giolitti no. 55, or via e-mail to the following address: info@flatartbookfair.com.

REVOCAZIONE OF THE NEWSLETTER SERVICE
