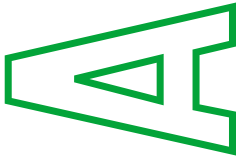

FLAT PRIZE /

FOUNDATION 2019
REGULATIONS

Art. 1 – Characteristics and purpose of the Prize

The Prize is promoted by the Cultural Association FLAT and by CRT Foundation for Modern and Contemporary Art within FLAT Fiera Libro Arte Torino. The Prize is presented for the exclusive purpose of producing unpublished projects in order to intervene on the promotion of the international contemporary art publishing industry.

Art. 2 – Participants admitted

The Prize is reserved to the publishers participating at the current fair as Exhibitors. The participation to the FLAT Prize is not mandatory.

It's possible to participate with any kind of unpublished project on the contemporary art field. Each participant can present one sole project.

Art. 3 – Terms and conditions of the participation's submission

The participation at the FLAT Prize is free and subordinated to the acceptance of this regulation.

The participation has to contain:

- the participation format (filled in every part in English language only);
- copy of the present regulation for participation dated and signed for acceptance;
- a maximum of 5 images, useful in order to show the publishing idea.
- All the above documents must be sent to the address prize@flatartbookfair.com within October 10th, 2019. Any participation received later will not be accepted.

All the files must be in .pdf format. If the participants would like to send more than one image, they must send all the images in a unique .pdf file. Single files or .jpeg files will not be accepted.

Art. 4 – Selection of the winning project

The participations will be subject to the evaluation of the Organization and Scientific Committee, constituted by Liliana Dematteis, Richard Flood, David Senior, Ken Soehner and Lawrence Weiner, with an unquestionable and definitive vote. The decision will be shortly motivated.

Art. 5 – Prize assignment

The winner will receive an amount of Euro 10.000,00 (gross of withholding tax if due) for the realization of its publishing project, after the presentation of the final product during FLAT 2020.

The winner will be announced during the FLAT edition 2019 and the publishing project has to be realised and finalised during the following year, in order to be presented during FLAT edition 2020.

The Prize is not assignable to third parties.

Art. 6 – Winner's obligations

The winner undertakes to give two free copies of the publishing project to FLAT and CRT Foundation for Contemporary and Modern Art. The Foundation will give its copy to the Giorgio Maffei Fund, established at GAM (Civic Gallery of Modern and Contemporary Art) in Turin.

The winner undertakes to mention the “*FLAT Prize / CRT Art Foundation, 2019*” within the colophon of the project and also in all promotional channels, which will be used for its distribution.

Art. 7 – Undertaking not to disclose

The project cannot be presented before the FLAT edition 2020, when it will be officially launched; on the contrary, the Prize will be annulled.

Art. 8 – Authorizations

The Exhibitors participating to the FLAT Prize guarantee that they have all necessary authorizations relating to words and images contained in their project; therefore, they shall indemnify and hold FLAT harmless from any claim of third parties referring to violations of their rights because of the use of such publishing project.

The winner editor authorizes FLAT to promote the winner editorial project through its promotional channels.

Art. 9 – Acceptance of the regulation

The participation to the FLAT Prize implies the acceptance of all clauses contained in this regulation.

Art. 10 – Privacy

The participants, who join the FLAT Prize, agree that their personal data, given for the participation, will be used in accordance with the relevant Privacy rules (EU Regulation no. 679/2016).

The personal data given to FLAT will be processed with manual and computer instruments for the unique purpose of this initiative realization.

The personal data will be updated, if necessary, and will be stored in a manner that allows the identification of the concerned person for the time strictly necessary in order to accomplish the purposes for which they have been collected and used. The participant is aware that he can exercise the access rights provided for in article 15 of the EU Regulation no. 679/2016, sending his request to the controller, through an e-mail to be addressed to direction@flatartbookfair.com.

The controller is FLAT, Cultural Association, Fiscal Code C.F. 97805090012, Vat number 11768180017, with registered office in Turin, via Giovanni Giolitti no. 55, in person of its legal representative, Ms. Chiara Caroppo.

Art. 11 – Applicable law, Jurisdiction

The present regulation of participation shall be governed by the laws of Italy.

Any dispute arising out between the organization and the participants under this regulation of participation shall be settled exclusively by the Courts located in Turin, Italy.
